3. It functions as an intergovernmental body under the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change (UNFCCC).

Q5. With reference to the Vidyanjali Programme, consider the following statements:

1. It seeks to strengthen government schools through community and volunteer participation.
2. It is aligned with the objectives of the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020.
3. The programme mandates compulsory financial contributions from local communities.

Which of the statements given above is/are correct?

Answer: (b)

Statements 1 and 2 are correct.

Statement 3 is incorrect: participation and contributions are ****voluntary****, not mandatory.

Solutions:

1. Answer: (a)

Statement 1 is correct: the waste sector's share is low but impactful.

Statement 2 is correct: methane dominates emissions.

Statement 3 is incorrect: methane's global warming potential is **much higher** than CO₂.

2. Answer: (a)

Statements 1 and 2 are correct.

Statement 3 is incorrect: SBTi is **not** an intergovernmental UN body; it is an independent charity.

3. Answer: (b)

Statements 1 and 2 are correct.

Statement 3 is incorrect: many LSDs manifest in **childhood**, often with severe outcomes.

4.

Answer: (b)

Statement 1 is correct: it is endemic to the Western Ghats.

Statement 2 is incorrect: it inhabits **evergreen and semi-evergreen rainforests**.

Statement 3 is correct: recent studies suggest adaptation to modified habitats.
