World Pandemic Treaty

Members of the World Health Organization (WHO) have finalized a proposal for the World Pandemic Treaty.

The proposal was finalised by the Intergovernmental Negotiating Body (INB), It would be presented in May at the 78th World Health Assembly for consideration.

Objective of the Treaty

To ensure coordinated global response to pandemics while strengthening national and global:

Prevention strategies

Preparedness capacities

Resilience of health systems

Equitable access to pandemic-related resources

Need for the Treaty

Fragmented Global Response

The treaty would promote international cooperation and harmonised policy responses during public health emergencies.
