Gond art is a famous tribal folk art of India, practiced mainly by the Gond tribe of Madhya Pradesh, Chhattisgarh, Maharashtra, Odisha, and Andhra Pradesh.

Key Features

Style: Dots, lines, dashes, and vibrant patterns

Colors: Bright natural colors (earlier from plants, charcoal, soil)

Themes: Nature, animals, birds, trees, gods, daily life, folklore.

Concept: Everything in nature is alive and connected.

Traditionally painted on walls, floors, and mud houses

Believed to bring good luck and protection
