SOLUTIONS:

1. Answer: (a) 1 and 2 only

Divyang Sahara Yojana is implemented under the Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment.

It aims to provide affordable modern assistive devices to persons with disabilities (Divyangjan).

Statement 3 is incorrect as it is not under the Ministry of Health.

2. Answer: (a) 1 and 2 only

Divyangjan Kaushal Yojana provides industry-relevant skill training for persons with disabilities.

Training sectors include IT, Animation, Visual Effects, Gaming & Comics (AVGC), Hospitality, and Food & Beverages.

It is implemented under the Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment, not the Ministry of Skill Development.

3. Answer: (d) 1, 2 and 3

Government invoked emergency powers to increase LPG production for domestic use.

The Strait of Hormuz is a crucial route for India's crude oil and LPG imports.

Qatar supplies nearly half of India's LNG imports, making supply disruptions significant.

4. Answer: (d) 1, 2 and 3

NH-GCI provides a scientific and quantitative assessment of green cover along national highways.

It was developed by NHAI in collaboration with ISRO's National Remote Sensing Centre (NRSC).

The first assessment covered about 30,000 km of national highways across 24 states.

5. Answer: (b) An initiative to replace kerosene lamps with solar lighting in rural communities

Lighting a Billion Lives (LaBL) 2.0, launched by TERI with the Ministry of New & Renewable Energy, aims to promote solar lighting and replace kerosene lamps in rural areas, improving clean energy access.
