1. (a) 1 and 3 only

Explanation: ECOSOC is one of the six UN organs with 54 members elected for 3-year terms. It coordinates agencies for Agenda 2030.

2. (b) A financial derivative that transfers credit risk between parties

Explanation: CDS allows investors to hedge or transfer credit risk.

3. (d) 1, 2 and 3

Explanation: These sensors are inspired by frogs, use nanofibres, and exhibit adaptive memory behavior.

4. (a) 1 and 3 only

Explanation: Oak trees belong to Quercus and are climax species in Himalayan forests, not coastal regions.

5. (c) 1, 2 and 3

Explanation: It is observed on April 10, marks Hahnemann's birth, and NCH regulates homoeopathy in India.
